This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Fresh Affiliation Up to Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 30. Further increase of section shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws and subject to the availability of room size of greater than 500 sq ft.
2	The ramps at the entrance don't have safety hand rails.The school has overlaid a ramp over a staircase to access the upper floors, which is steep and unsafe and not as per norms.It is covered by a carpet , held down by wooden slats which is again unsafe for navigation . The school shall dismantle the same and construct a proper

	ramp as per norms of RPwD ACT and guidelines issued by the Board or install a lift and affix hand rails along the ramps at the entrance within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
3	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets which are too small and narrow for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. signage is temporary. The grab bars are incorrectly placed. CWSN toilets are not seen on all the three floors. The school shall construct separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
4	The height of concrete boundary wall in some part is seen less than 6 feet (ref IC video 0:13). Hence the school is directed to raise the concrete boundary wall at least 6 feet in all sides and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal with videography.
5	A transformer seen inside the school campus (ref IC video 1:03). The school is directed to cordon it off with concrete /iron mesh enclosure for the safety of students and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal with videography.
6	The school name is mentioned as Shree Swaminarayan Gurukul International School instead of Shree Swaminarayan Gurukul School (as in application) in the school website and the documents like:- recognition certificate, land certificate, building safety certificate and water and sanitation certificate. Hence the school is directed to correct the school name in school website, obtain revised documents with correct school name and upload the same on SARAS portal within 3 months.
7	The school has shown total 30 classrooms however dimension wise the school has shown 0 (zero) classrooms. Now the school has given an undertaking on Mandatory Public Disclosure stating that all the class room are 560 sq. ft (20 x 28). The school is directed to upload the undertaking (showing dimension of classrooms) on SARAS portal within 3 months.
8	From the IC video it is seen that the school is having three building blocks however the school has mentioned only one building block. The school is directed to obtain building safety, fire safety certificates, make CWSN facilities in all the building blocks and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
9	The composite lab is not as per SoP issued by the Board, the equipment's are displayed on tables of improper shapes and sizes, there is no proper fittings/ installation and workstations. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the lab as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal. with videography.
10	The library is seen as under sized and understocked. Hence the school is directed to shift it to a bigger room, purchase more books and upgrade the library as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal with videography.
11	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Vijaywada within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal.

Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
